

Long-Term Service Associate Discount Card Application

Eligibility Requirements

In order to receive a Long-Term Service Discount Card:

- You are at least 55 years of age and have 15 years of continuous service; or
- You have 20 or more years of continuous service. Termination for gross misconduct will disqualify you for a discount card.

Things to Know

- In the event of your death, your spouse/partner will be eligible to keep the discount card for life.
 - Once Benefits is notified of your death, a discount card will be ordered for your spouse/partner.
 - If your spouse/partner is a current or former associate terminated for gross misconduct, he/she will be disqualified from receiving a discount card.
- If your card is not used within a 12-month period, it will be subject for cancellation. You would need to contact Benefits to reapply.
- Lost or stolen cards should be promptly reported to Benefits to prevent any potential abuse of your discount card.
- Long-Term Service Discount Card applications should be submitted within 30 days of your anticipated last date of employment to avoid any interruption in your discount card benefit.
- **NOTE:** Applications received more than 30 days prior to your anticipated last day of employment will be denied, and you will need to fill out a new application once you leave the company.
